English for Aviators Course

Learning a new language is a difficult and enduring task that requires self immersion and discipline. However, adding the complexity of learning the way aviator's use English over a noisy radio and in a hectic environment can be a daunting task even for a native speaker.

Who is this course for?

This course is for students with an intermediate reading and conversational level. Students who have not reached this level must continue with their studies of general English until intermediate proficiency level has been achieved. We recommend courses at our local community college www.mdc.edu as the best and most affordable programs in the area.

How long is the course?

The complete course consists of 2 levels for a total of 75 hours of instructor led classes (37.5 hours for each level). The student may take one or both levels.

What is covered in the course?

The course uses two texts from AE Link Publications, Inc. (www.a-e-link.com). Additionally, extra emphasis is placed on pronunciation and listening to live ATC transmissions.

What is the schedule?

We recommend 2 hour classes, 4 days a week. The course will last approximately 2 months. Class times can be adapted to meet the needs of the student.

What is the cost?

Both courses cost \$4000, or, \$2000 for one course. Additional study is charged at \$40 per hour. The books are sold at a cost of \$74.95 per set (plus \$7.50 shipping) or \$48.95 each (plus \$5.00 shipping).

How many students can be in the class?

The prices are quoted for one student. If more than one student joins the class, the cost may be split between them plus a \$50 charge.

E.g. Cost for a 2 student class: \$2050 per student.

When does the course start?

The courses start according to student and instructor availability.
